S. No	Policy Name	Policy & Procedure Scope	Reviewed
1	NRNA Code Of Conduct	Includes NRNA Code of Conduct, which provides guidance applicable to all the members of the International Coordination Council (ICC) and National Coordination Councils (NCCs) of the NRN Association globally.	
2	NRNA NCC & ICC Election	Contains the process of election, review of voting rights and the membership rights as well as regulation for the election. This should be in line with constitution, membership and code of conduct policy.	
3	NRNA Conflict of Interest	Identify the different types of conflicts of interest that may arise and recognise various possible situations.	
4	NRNA Constitution and Amendment	Contains the review of Constitution with date and time. Should also include the review process and procedures.	
5	NRNA Task Force, Committee, Sub-Committee and Their Roles and Responsibilities	Contains the duties and roles and responsibilities of the team belonging to Task Force and Committee as well as Sub-Committee	
6	NRNA Committee Formation and Review Policy	Contains the process of the formation and review of the Task-Force, Committee and Sub-Committee	
7	NRNA Disciplinary Action (Standard and Review)	Contains the disciplinary action process (verbal, written). Also includes the definitions of misconduct and misbehaviour within organization.	
8	NRNA Rules & Regulations	Contains rules and regulations of each NCC, ICC, Youth Forum, Women Forum and any other team within the organization.	
9	NRNA Conference Policy	Contains the hosting place, timing and guidelines of the Conferences and Regional Meetings. Should follow the regulations.

10	Ethical and Confidential Policy (Standard and Review)	Contains Ethical Policy of the organization and should include the Privacy & Confidentiality Standard where it must embrace the protection, correction, disclosure, collection, use & access of personal and any organizational information.	
11	NRNA Membership Policy	Contains the NRNA membership requirement and guidelines to follow.	
12	NRNA Meeting and Record Keeping Standard	Contains a set of standards, regulations and record keeping of the meetings.	
13	NRNA Organizational Structure and Brand (logo) Policy	Contain the policy and standard for the organizational structure and logo. It should also address the organizational deficiencies and amend as per the constitution/associated rules and regulation.
