Activities and accomplishments:

Three major activities have been underway and are at different stages of operation since the Committee was formed less than a year ago.

- 1. Preparation of NRN-SKI personnel database: It has been realized that ICC-SKI has been working for some time on the preparation of SKI NRN personnel database of NRNs spread over the world. Hence, NCC Australia SKI Committee realizes that it would be a significant contribution if we could prepare the updated database of NRN SKI personnel living in Australia. All the SKI committee members have been given responsibility to contact the NRNs in Australia through their own techniques and methods and come up with a list of the SKI personnel. Some members have already prepared the list while others are still working on this. We hope to continue this task and prepare the updated database in the coming months. Once such a database is prepared, it will be published in the NRN Australia website and will also be submitted to ICC-SKI Committee to merge this into the global NRNA SKI database.
- 2. **Formation of NRN Australia Professional Group in Linkdin**: We have created a open group of NRN Australia Professional Group in Linkdin. Currently 26 members have joined and become active in discussions. We have published the news about the NRN Australia SKI workshop on 19th July in Sydney in this group in Linkdin. We encourage each and every NRN SKI personnel to join this group and take part in discussions. - 3. **Organising NRN-NCC SKI workshop**: As an important activity under the SKI project, the NRN-NCC SKI Committee will organize a national-level workshop on 19th July in Sydney. The Committee is working hard to make it highly professional and successful. Two keynote speakers have been invited and other eleven full papers have been accepted for presentation during the workshop.
