Summary Report of Social Entrepreneurship Development Subcommittee

1. Nrn Laghubitta Program

After two years of struggle, one of the ambitious project of this committee is in operation since January 2019. The social investment project (Nrn Microfinance) is providing direct job to 282 youths and 1.5 billion loans to the 17,000 entrepreneurs which is creating thousands of jobs. Further more we reached in 189 Rural Municipality with 41 thousands members. Thus we are delighted to express that this project being one of the fast growing and the most impactful project in Nepal in the field of financial deepening and inclusion.



2. Support on Blood Donation Program:

The Committee has coordinated to organize a blood donation program with a cooperation of Nrn Lagubitta Bittiya Sanstha Ltd. 46 healthy people has donated blood in 14 Ashad 2076 at far western part of Nepal (Dhangadi). Similarly, it has supported on another blood donation program organized by Nepal Youth Council (NYC Nepal) on 30 December 2018.



3. Wheel Chair Program

With a motto of "By Disable and for Disable" the Social Entrepreneurship committee has introduced the wheel chair assembling plant in Nepal. From the first meeting of the committee it has been decided to contribute Rs. 1 (one) million to the project. It will create employment to the disable people and support to the disable people with sustainable local production of 1000 wheelchair. Further more the Mobility Device Kathmandu and Non-Resident Nepali Association (NRNA ICC), Sakura wheelchair Project, have shown their interest to explore cooperation in wheelchair related programs and their projects on social environment change and new developments, especially, in the field of Wheelchair for disabled persons as well as other areas of mutual interest. The NRNA, **Ministry of Women, Children and Senior Citizen**, Mobility Device, Sakura and many other local NGOs are partners of the project.
