



President Report VI submitted to International Coordination Council (ICC) during 76th ICC meeting.

In my Vth report to ICC a had reported on activities of NRNA ICC till 15th November, 2020 and after that we have mostly concentrated in preparation of Special International General Assembly (SIGA) online and Emerging Nepal Fund. A mandated by the 9th International General Assembly; endorsed by the 75th ICC meeting and authorized by MOFA; we are holding our SIGA on 23rd and 24th January, 2021 and the preparation is ongoing and I seek your support and cooperation in making it a success.

As of yet 44 NRNs have committed to invest in Emerging Nepal Fund as promoters and a total of 908 million rupees have already been committed. Our consultant and legal advisor are in the process of registering the company in Nepal and as advised by the Company Register's office the name of the company many need to be changed to "NRN Emerging Fund".

The effect of the COVID-19 pandemic is not resolved and most of have not been able to travel but we are regularly lobbying with the government in addressing NRN issues such as NRN Citizenship, NRN Act, establishment of NRNA Foundation etc. Though the situation is not ideal; we have not deviated from our objectives and are regularly assessing our goals and trying to move ahead in the best possible way.

COVID-19 Response to Nepali Migrant Workers program is progressing smoothly and the number of individuals provided with service is much encouraging than in my last report. Till 11/01/2021 altogether 9650 individuals have been benefitted. NCCs Qatar, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Kathmandu office and others have provided service to 2273, 1797, 1479, 1563, 2503 and 35 individuals respectively and the trend is on the rise.

Regular interaction between the IES/ OB members and other stakeholders on issues related to NRNA is ongoing and some details have been highlighted for your reference. Nepal is still in need of various preventive medical products to contain the COVID-19 pandemic; especially, the vaccine. I request all NRNs to unite in providing support to the Government. Given below are some highlights.

- On November, 19th 2020, I held meeting with the members of Constitution Amendment Committee, past presidents and the General Secretary to discuss on issues related to Constitution Amendment.
- On November 19th 2020, we also opened the bid for the Public Restroom project, one of the flagship projects of NRNA.
- On November 20th 2020, meeting of Emerging Nepal Fund steering committee was held to discuss about the registration of the company in Nepal.
- On 21st November 2020, IES held meeting with Presidents, General Secretaries and Treasurers of Americas, Oceania and Asia Pacific regions to discuss about the financial sources of the regions.
- On 22nd November, 2020 the 75th ICC meeting was held; where issues related to Special International General Assembly (SIGA) were discussed and 23rd and 24th of January, 2021 was finalized as the dates for SIGA.

- On 25th November, 2020, Women Forum of Oceania Region held 15 days campaign against gender violence and other gender related issues.
- On 28th November, 2020 the Constitution Amendment Committee held meeting with advisors and Honorary Council members of all the six regions.
- On 29th November, 2020 meeting with Smart NRNA Taskforce was held to discuss about the new website of NRNA.
- On 30th November, 2020 meeting of NRNA Sports Academy was held to discuss on how NRNA could contribute to the sport sector.
- On 5th December, 2020 the First Asia Pacific Regional Youth meeting was held to discuss on issues related to youth and how they could contribute to the NRN movement.
- On 5th December, 2020 27th IES meeting was held to discuss on issues related to NRNA.
- On 6th December, 2020 meeting of the Emerging Nepal Fund steering committee was held.
- On 16th December, 2020 meeting was held between members of Constitution Amendment Committee and IES to discuss on the proposed amendment on the NRNA Constitution 2003 (Amendment 2017) to be presented in the Special International General Assembly.
- On 18th December, 2020 meeting with Emerging Nepal Fund steering committee members was held.
- On 18th December, 2020 NRNA Mobile Blood Bus was handed to Bharatpur Metropolitan to be operated by Bharatpur Red Cross.
- On 20th December, 2020 the 28th IES meeting was held to discuss on issues of SIGA, MIS system and free membership.
- On 21st December, 2020 a meeting of the Constitution Amendment Committee was held to discuss on proposed amendment to be presented during the SIGA.
- On 24th 25th and 27th December, 2020 discussion on proposed amendment to be presented in the SIGA was held amongst all NCCs, RCs and DRCs by the Constitution Amendment Committee.
- On 1st January, 2020, the 28th IES meeting was held to discuss on issues related to NRNA and SIGA; being held from 23rd January, 2021.
- On 2nd January, 2021, Constitution Committee held meeting with Women Leaders of NRNA on the proposed amendment in the NRNA Constitution.
- On 3rd January, 2021 a meeting was held between Asia Pacific, Oceania, Americas, Africa, Middle East and Europe Region and the members of the Constitution Committee members.
- On 4th January, 2021 IES members participate in a presentation made by the NRNA Sports Academy official on how NRNA could participate on the 9th National Games and the cost associated with it.
- On 10th January, 2021 application to be delegates in the SIGA was closed and 2687 applied.
- On 11th January, 29th IES/OB meeting was held with the members of the Constitution Amendment Committee; where three column presentation on the proposed amendment of the NRNA Constitution was presented and discussed upon.
