INTRODUCTION

The NRNA Sports Academy is one of the important task forces amongst other various task forces of the Non-Resident Nepali Association. It is an important sports body related to youth and athletes. It has been established with the plan and objective of enhancing the pride and prestige of Nepal by hoisting the flag. It was formally established in 2019 A.D. at the 9th World Conference of the Non-Resident Nepali Association Held in Kathmandu.

VISION

Sports are an important means of keeping a person healthy. A player can enhance the pride and prestige of the nation through sports, sports is the only field that creates a sense of unity and nationalism in the common man. Therefore, it is important to develop and promote sports among all Nepalese, whether inside or outside the country. It helps people stay healthy and fit, as well as provides important opportunities to support and contribute to the nation through sports.

MISSION

The NRNA Sports Academy plans to make the best use of the latest sports skills, knowledge and technology available to Nepali citizens around the world and foreign nationals of Nepali origin to assist in the development and promotion of sports in their homeland. International sports competitions, such as the South Asian Games, the Asian Games and the Olympic Games can be well-attended and well-executed by bringing together Nepali sportsmen and sports-lovers scattered abroad and bringing them up to standard. With these things in mind, the Non-Resident Nepali Association has moved forward with participation in sports and the triad of sports as an important campaign.

GOAL

- To develop and expand standard sports among non-resident Nepali players and participate in Nepali sports and cooperate with sports bodies of Nepal for sports development.
- To produce skilled and qualified players and to provide necessary support for the nation to participate in international sports competitions carrying the flag of the country.
- Through the quality athletes prepared by NRNA Sports Academy, Athletes will win the highest number of medals in national level sports competitions and will participate in the Olympic Games, which is an important destination of Sports, within the next 5 years and won Olympic medals within the next 10 years.



Brief History

According to the NRNA's idea and plan to contribute to Nepal's sports sector by exchanging sports knowledge, skills and latest technology acquired by non-resident Nepalese abroad, NRNA ICC Sports Committee was formed as a working group after the 8th Non-Resident Nepali World Conference in 2017. After the discussion and meeting of various stages in the initiative and efforts of the Sports Committee, the Government of Nepal, Ministry of Youth and Sports, National Sports Council and Non-Resident Nepali Association agreed to allow non-resident Nepali players to participate and compete like Nepali players and other departmental teams of Nepal. An MOU was signed on 29/9.

The agreement has paved the way for non-resident Nepali Association to enter the Nepali sports arena. Immediately after the agreement, the Nepal Chapter of NRNA ICC Sports Committee started the necessary technical preparations for participation in the 8th National Games-2075 organized by the National Sports Council.









In a short period of time, the NRNA has recruited 18 players from 6 different sports. Badri KC and ICC Sports Committee Chair and Youth Coordinator Sudan Thapa participated as a leader of Non-Resident Nepali Athletes in the Eighth National Games for the first time. NRNA's first participation in this competition was a satisfying and remarkable success. It has provided great inspiration and encouragement to all non-resident Nepalese. At the grassroots level, NRNA has succeeded in gaining fame and notoriety.







A total of 18 athletes competed in 6 sports including tennis, swimming, karate, taekwondo, boxing and judo. Out of the total 18 players, NRNA swimmer Nathan Dorje Sherpa (USA) won 7 medals including 5 gold and 2 bronze medals. Tennis player Samrakshak Bhushan Bajracharya (Australia), 1 gold and 1 bronze medal, tennis player Amrit Poudel (Australia) won 1 Bronze, In Karate Subhadra Shrestha (Canada) won 1 silver, on the other hand Shanti Adhikari (Macau) won 1 bronze in Karate as well, In Judo, Mohan Bam (Australia) won one bronze and boxing's Pradip Ghimire (India) won one bronze and in lawn tennis Dawa Sonam Sherpa (Thailand) won one bronze and won a total of 15 medals.

Samrakshak Bhushan Bajracharya, Nepal's tennis champion and NRNA's player patron, represented Nepal in the '13th South Asian Games' held in Nepal in 2076 BS and was awarded an international medal for the first time in the 65-year history of Nepal's tennis game.

Immediately after the conclusion of the Eighth National Games 2075, the Non-Resident Nepali Association Sports Committee organized a grand honors ceremony in Kathmandu with cash prizes and certificates in honor of the players who won medals in the competition. At the ceremony, the Non-Resident Nepali Association awarded winner athletes with Cash Prize Rs. 1 lakh for Gold Medalist, Rs. 50 thousand for Silver Medalist and Rs 25,000 for Bronze Medalists. The ceremony was held under the patronage of Bhaban Bhatta, the then president of the Non-Resident Nepali Association.

The entry of the Non-Resident Nepali Association into the Nepali sports arena is short but glorious. During its sports campaign, NRNA ICC Sports Committee Nepal Chapter organized a one-day seminar on the development of sports in Nepal on September 21, 2019. The











Seminar was Held in the presence of various sports coaches, the workshop had an in-depth discussion on various aspects of sports development in Nepal. The Nepal Chapter handed over a letter of thanks to the coaches who played an important role in coaching the eighth National Games and handed over a tennis sports kit to gold medalist Samrakshak Bhusan Bajracharya on the same occasion.

During the sports activities, the Non-Resident Nepali Association Sports Committee organized an NRNA Heritage Walkathon with the participation of veteran runners including Olympic marathon runner Baikuntha Manandhar on the occasion of the 9th World Conference of the Non-Resident Nepali Association.

On the occasion of the World Conference, the Nepal Chapter of the Non-Resident Nepali Association Sports Committee organized the Inter NRNA Cup Futsal Competition in October 2019. The Nepal Sports Journalist Federation team from Nepal won the competition, while the Non-Resident Nepali Association UAE from the Middle East came second and the Nepal Chapter team came third.





















The Non-Resident Nepali Association Sports Foundation is very excited about the participation and achievements in the Eighth National Games 2075 BS. A new faith and hope has been communicated in the Nepali sports world. Moreover, the establishment of a sports academy as a separate body of non-resident Nepali players has provided more encouragement to all players and sportspersons.

The encouragement and enthusiasm gained in the past has inspired us to contribute more in the field of sports. In this connection, we have the 9th edition of the Nepali National Games
